The Freedom Project, Hillstown Methodist Church

The Council is very pleased to be supporting the recently-opened Freedom Project Centre at Hillstown Methodist Church.

The Freedom Project was launched locally in 2009 and its 150 volunteer workers now operate from 14 different sites across North Derbyshire, North Notts and South Yorkshire.

Founder Mark North explains: "We aim to support people on the edge to make changes in their lives by providing free counselling and advice about debt, benefits, housing and mental health. We can assist with formfilling and at tribunals and offer general advice."

The centre operates a free café open to all on Tuesday and Friday mornings, 9.00 to 12.30. It is hoped this will be extended to a five-day service in the future. Work will soon begin to provide more private interview rooms.
